Demonstrating Our Positive Impact



The Need

14% of young people in Ventura County fail to graduate from high school on time.²

How We Innovated

We gathered funding to create a new STEAM Makerspace and added 40 new Chromebook computers.

What We Do

DIY STEM, Junior Staff, Money Matters, National Arts Competition, Power Hour (for homework), Project Learn, Technology Computer Science, and Ultimate Journey (environmental science).

Our Impact

Among our teen-aged Club members, 99% expect to graduate from high school, and 90% expect to complete some kind of post-secondary educa-

The Need

13% of high-school youth in Ventura County were involved in a physical fight in the past year.³

How We Innovated

Our Club lead anti-bullying and mentorship programs.

What We Do

Keystone Club, Targeted Outreach, Torch Club, Youth of the Month.

Our Impact

60% of Club teen members volunteer in their community at least once per year, while 40% volunteer in their community at least once per month.





The Need

35% of young people ages 10-18 in Ventura County are over-weight or obese.4

How We Innovated

We delivered 90 cases of water, and 4,000 sealed snacks monthly to Clubs, increased safety measures across all Clubs and ramped up social and emotional partnerships and regular check-ins with all children and teens.

What We Do

Individual Sports, Passport to Manhood, SMART Girls, Smart Moves, Triple Play Daily Challenge, Triple Play Healthy Habits, and locally-developed programs fostering healthy lifestyles.

Our Impact

75% of Club members ages 9 and older report getting at least an hour of physical activity on five or more days per week.
